



# HEAD BOYS BASKETBALL COACH

## *Adams Central High School*

### Position Overview

Adams Central High School is seeking a dynamic leader for its K-12 boys basketball program starting with the 2026–2027 season.

As a key member of the athletic staff, the next head coach will oversee all aspects of the boys basketball program, continuing a tradition of success, growth, and community engagement.

### Adams Central Basketball Context

- Location: Monroe, IN, about 20 miles south of Fort Wayne.
- Adams Central High School is part of the Allen County Athletic Conference (ACAC) in Northeast Indiana.
- The school competes in 2A, Sectional #36.
- Current high school enrollment: ~400+ students.

### AC Program Strength & History

- Strong and dedicated boys basketball booster club support, helping fund many aspects of the basketball program.
- Robust established elementary basketball program: camps, clinics, travel teams.
- Hosts three large tournaments annually (grades 3–6), often with 30+ teams (teams schedule for upcoming events this season).
- Typically fields a freshman and/or C-team each season.
- Among 55 teams in major Northeast Indiana conferences, Adams Central ranks in the top 10 in total wins over the past five seasons.
- The boys basketball team is one of the leaders in the ACAC conference in total wins over the last five year and ten year time frames.
- The school won both the regular season and conference tournament titles in 2023 and 2024.





## AC Facilities

- Home games held in “The Hangar”, a classic 1951 Indiana gym refurbished in 2021 (locker rooms remodeled).
- A modern Student Activity Center (opened 2018) houses three courts, locker rooms, etc. — used for practices, camps, and middle-school games.
- All K–12 students share the same campus — meaning the coach has full oversight of the K–12 boys’ basketball program.
- Dedicated weight room facility accessible to athletes during and after the school day.

## Head Coach Role

Adams Central is currently evaluating teaching openings for the next school year. At this time, all teaching licenses will be considered, and candidates in any subject area are encouraged to apply.

The hiring process will seek to have a coach who can teach or work in our corporation, however all applications will be considered on the basis of experience.
