Short Description:

Head Girls Basketball Coach

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Reports directly to the Athletic Director.
- Responsible for the direction and progress of his/her program.
- Operates his/her athletic program within the philosophy, mission, and vision of Noblesville Schools, Noblesville High School and the athletic department student-athlete code of conduct.
- Is fully aware of his/her legal responsibilities in regard to student-athlete safety including informing student-athletes of the dangers associated with the specific sport.
- Completes all IHSAA entries in a timely manner as directed by the athletic director.
- Provides an accurate roster of team members (including managers and other student support staff) to the athletic department one week prior to the first game/scrimmage of the season. Note: It is recognized that a team roster may change during the course of a season. Coaches are asked to send any roster updates and changes to the athletic department as they occur.
- Works in cooperation with the athletic director in regard to schedule requests and changes.
- Work within the rules of the IHSAA in regard to appropriate practices in scouting opponents. It is expected that the head coach will make an effort to scout an opponent (when appropriate) and develop game plans accordingly.
- Required to develop daily/weekly practice plans and keep them for their records. In these practice plans coaches should note when they cover sport safety items.
- Keep and maintain appropriate records and statistics reflecting game results and individual/team accomplishments and submitting them in a timely manner to the appropriate media/school/conference sources as required by the athletic

director.

-Set appropriate team rules and regulations and ensures that the athlete and parent(s) are made aware of such rules and regulations. The coach shall attempt to instill in every participant the need for intense personal effort, discipline, perseverance, and ongoing pursuit of excellence for the good of the group.

Skills/Requirements:

- Strong Communicator with players and parents
- Excellent at building relationships with student-athletes
- Strong basketball knowledge-Leading student-athletes in the development of tolerance, respect for the opposition, and effective interpersonal relationships shall be a role of each head coach.
- The attitude of each coach should be positive, and the influence on his/her teams should stimulate expectations of excellence. Each coach shall attempt to instill an attitude of confidence, desire for success, and an appreciation for sportsmanship.
- Require the highest level of sportsmanship and hold student-athletes and coaching staff accountable who do not exhibit appropriate sportsmanship.
- Inherent in the position of a head coach is an obligation that each coach must be willing to accept. He/she shall serve as a role model in terms of character, positive influence, attitude, and the desire to be a life-long learner in his/her sport.
- Maintain open lines of communication with student-athletes during the course of the season.
