 - **Instruction:** Plan and execute rigorous daily practices focused on fundamental skill work, situational strategy, and physical conditioning.
 - **Staff Supervision:** Recruit, mentor, and evaluate assistant coaches at the high school, junior high, and elementary levels to ensure vertical alignment.
 - **Student Advocacy:** Monitor the academic progress of student-athletes; enforce team and school rules regarding eligibility and conduct.
 - **Administrative Tasks:** Coordinate with the Athletic Director for scheduling, transportation, equipment inventory, and budget management.
 - **Community Engagement:** Foster positive relationships with parents, alumni, and the "Cougar" community; lead summer camps and youth clinics to build the future of the program.
